

Safety and compliance are of the upmost importance with all school formals held at ICC Sydney. There will be zero tolerance to any illegal or undesirable conduct. It is important that you understand legislative requirements, proof of age requirements, conditions of entry and behavioural expectations for all attendees.

LEGISLATIVE REQUIREMENTS

All guests are expected to adhere to the relevant legislation below. Police will be contacted in cases relating to illegal activity.

- Occupational Health & Safety Act 2000
- Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 (NSW)
- Liquor Act 2007 (NSW)
- Crimes Act 1900 (NSW)

PROOF OF AGE

Any person that appears under the age of 25 will be checked for identification. Identification must be valid, contain a photograph of the bearer and prove that the person is a minimum of 18 years of age (Driver's licence, Passport, RSA Photo Card).

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (bag inspection and intoxication)

- Breathalysers will be used at entry points for all minors (any persons under the age of 18 years) attending. Any reading above 0.00 will result in the minor being denied entry to the event and requested to leave.
- Under certain circumstances it may be requested that individual hand bags or carry bags be presented for inspection.
- Any person found to be attempting to bring alcohol onto licensed premises will be denied entry to the event and requested to leave.
- Any person found to be showing signs of intoxication will be denied entry to the event and requested to leave the premises.
- Any person found to be in the possession of an illegal drug will be referred to the police. There will be zero tolerance to any illegal activity.

BEHAVIOURAL EXPECTATIONS

- Any person found in an unauthorised area of the venue may be requested to leave.
- There will be zero tolerance to any anti-social, unruly, unlawful or violent behaviour and the offender(s) will be removed from the premises and/or referred to the police.
- Deliberate / malicious damage to property or assets will be referred to the police.
- Any person exhibiting signs of intoxication will be refused service and requested to leave the premises.
- Supply of alcohol to a minor will result in all involved parties being requested to leave the premises and the offending person(s) will be referred to the police.
- Any person that refuses to leave the premises when requested, will be referred to the police.
